Directions: Entering Macon on I-75 from the North, take exit 165 for I-16 East (toward Savannah). Keep your lane until you pass exit 1A. Coming from the South on I-75, take exit 165 for I-16 East (toward Savannah) and stay in the left exit lane until you pass exit 1A. Then, from either direction, stay in the right lane of I-16 and take exit 2 (ML King, Jr Boulevard and Coliseum Dr.) Turn left onto Coliseum Dr. at end of exit. At 2nd traffic light (Emery Highway), turn right and drive about 8/10 mile to the right turn into Ocmulgee National Monument. For parking, follow signs for the visitors' center.
